

ACTIONS GENERATED BY UNEXCUSED MEETINGS

Title 20A §1254 states that "This law allows a local school board to declare a vacancy on the board if a member is absent without excuse from three consecutive regular board meetings". The RSU 19 Board of Directors will notify, by mail, any individual board member of his/her second (2nd) unexcused absence. The notice will contain the date of the two (2) consecutive unexcused absences and the date of the next scheduled meeting. Should the member experience a third (3rd) consecutive unexcused absence, the chairman or vice-chairman in his/her absence, of RSU 19 Board of Directors will inform the appropriate selectman that a vacancy exists and that replacement procedures should begin. The notification will contain the dates of the unexcused meetings.

The Board's desire is to have members adhere to the preceding attendance standards with respect to attending sub-committee meetings assigned by the Chair. Two consecutive unexcused absences will result in a formal written notification to the individual member and the member's town manager or lead select board member.
