

**GRADUATION EXERCISES**

Seniors must meet Graduation requirements per policy IKF.

1. Seniors will march to the music Pomp and Circumstance, lining up according to height. Graduation gowns will be burgundy. Any student refusing to march with the person assigned to him/her will be dropped from all Graduation activities.
2. The school will provide music for Graduation activities.
3. The Graduation speaker will be chosen from a list approved by the Administration.
4. The Board Chairman or designee and Superintendent will participate in handing out diplomas.
5. Baccalaureate will be optional for student attendance.
6. Students who do not attend marching practices and class functions (Class night, etc.) will not be allowed to participate in Graduation exercise.
7. All monies, uniforms, books, etc., owed school or class will be paid/returned by the week prior to Graduation - otherwise no tickets to Graduation will be issued and the student will not be allowed to participate in Graduation activities.
8. The class will supervise all other aspects of their Graduation, upon approval of said activities by Advisors and Administration. These matters must be handled promptly and reasonable. The Advisors will assume responsibility for programs, tickets, and class parts with the knowledge of the class officers.
9. Those students who choose not to participate in Graduation will notify the office, in writing, by the week prior to Graduation. Students under 18 need their parents' signed permission. Diplomas will be given or mailed out to those students the day following Graduation.
