

**STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES
ON THE SCHOOL BOARD**

Two student representatives, selected by the High School Principal from the student body, will serve on the RSU 19 School Board for a minimum of one year. The representatives do not have voting powers but will attend and participate in regularly scheduled Board meetings. A School Board mentor will be assigned to each student representative.

Interested students need to possess a desire to be in a leadership role. They will be asked to serve as a liaison between the School Board and the student body. To do this, they must be able to elicit input and feedback from the entire student body.

The student representatives will need to advocate for all students and must feel comfortable communicating their thoughts and opinions to the School Board.

The student representatives may be asked to serve on School Board Committees. Participation in regular committee meetings is encouraged to reach a consensus to be forwarded to the Board for action.
